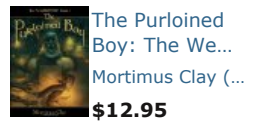

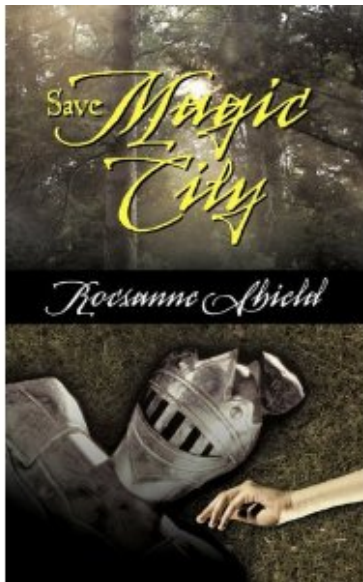

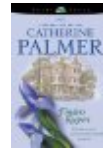

It should tell the reader that being independent and helping one's neighbours is more important in times of struggle than having a job for which one trembles every day in fear of losing it.
